I'm writing to note the ACLU-WA's interest in docket U-180525, regarding Advanced Metering Infrastructure. The ACLU-WA, along with a strong coalition of community organizations, has championed legislation in Seattle that places strong safeguards around data collection, use, and other dissemination by Seattle City Light and third parties in connection with Seattle's AMI deployment. We continue to urge the Commission to advance transparency, accountability, and fairness considerations in all AMI deployments through this rulemaking. Although we are not formally commenting on the current set of questions (largely directed to utilities) in the Commission's Notice of July 10th regarding this rulemaking, I am notifying the UTC as directed in that Notice to continue to keep me on the mailing list for this docket.
