TO ALL PARTIES:

On July 17, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Complaint for Penalties and Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Setting Time for Oral Statements on August 20, 2019, at 9:30 a.m. (Complaint) against Peninsula Sanitation Service, Inc., (Peninsula or Company) for alleged violations of Title 81 RCW and Chapter 480-07 WAC. That brief adjudicative proceeding was later rescheduled for October 16, 2019.

Pursuant to a joint request filed by Peninsula and Commission staff (Staff) on September 27, 2019, the Commission issued a Notice Cancelling Brief Adjudicative Proceeding and Requiring Status Report by October 18, 2019, at 5 p.m.

On October 18, 2019, Peninsula submitted a status report and, indicating Staff's agreement, requested that the Commission grant a two-week stay for any filing deadlines in this matter. Peninsula represented that settlement discussions between the parties had been meaningful and that the parties had "full confidence that a final settlement will be reached in the next two weeks."

Currently, the procedural schedule for this matter is suspended and there are no pending filing deadlines. The Commission finds good cause to grant the parties' request. The
