Dear Mr. Johnson:

On February 12, 2020, Commission staff (“Staff”) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Staff and Michael S. Miller, d/b/a Tiger Mountain Shuttle and Tiger Shuttle (“Company”) had reached a settlement in principle in this matter. Staff’s letter requested that the Commission cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding, set for February 25, 2020 at 1:30 p.m., to allow the parties time to finalize settlement documents. The Company supported the request. On February 14, 2020, the Commission granted Staff’s request and gave notice: (1) cancelling the brief adjudicative proceeding set for February 25, 2020; and (2) requiring the parties to file a settlement agreement or status report in this Docket by February 28, 2020.

On February 28, 2020, counsel for the Company contacted counsel for Staff, requesting an additional week to review the proposed settlement documents. Staff does not oppose this request. The parties therefore jointly and respectfully request that the Commission provide the parties an additional week to file a settlement agreement or status report in this Docket.
