**NOTICE REQUIRING SUPPLEMENTAL FILING**

**(Response due Friday, June 5, 2020, by 5 p.m.)**

RE: *In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties Against Super Friends Moving, LLC, d/b/a Super Friends Moving, Docket TV-190835*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On February 19, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01 instituting a special proceeding against Super Friends Moving, LLC, (Super Friends or Company) alleging violations of the Commission’s cease-and-desist order in Docket TV-170206 and seeking penalties.

On May 29, 2020, Commission staff (Staff) submitted a Settlement Agreement and Supporting Narrative on behalf of all of the parties to this proceeding.

The Commission observes that the Company’s owner, Jacob Raich, signed the Settlement Agreement as “Jakub Raich” and signed the Supporting Narrative as “Jacob Raich.” Raich has spelled his first name variously as “Jakub” or “Jacob” on multiple Commission documents, including several household goods applications, and has stated twice before an administrative law judge that his name is spelled “Jacob.” Raich’s driver’s license also bears the name “Jacob Raich.”

By this notice, the Commission requires a supplemental filing in this docket before the Commission will consider the Settlement Agreement. The parties must submit a Settlement Agreement signed by Raich as “Jacob Raich aka Jakub Raich.”

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE** The parties must re-file the Settlement Agreement and Supporting Narrative signed by Raich as “Jacob Raich aka Jakub Raich.” Both of these documents must be filed with the Commission no later than 5 p.m. on Friday, June 5, 2020.
