TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On June 22, 2020, PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company, (Pacific Power or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a Petition for Declaratory Order (Petition) in Docket UE-200573. The Petition requests that the Commission approve Pacific Power's proposed avoided cost rate methodology for power purchases from large qualifying facilities of greater than five megawatts pursuant to WAC 480-106-050(5). On June 23, 2020, the Commission issued a notice inviting interested persons to respond to the Petition by July 13, 2020.

On July 13, 2020, Commission staff (Staff) filed a response to the Petition. The Commission received no other responses to the Petition.

By statute and Commission rule, the Commission must take one of four specified actions within 30 days of receiving a petition for declaratory order. One such action is to set a specified time within 90 days of the date the petition was filed by which the Commission will enter a declaratory order.

By this Notice, the Commission sets a date by which it will enter a declaratory order.
