TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND PARTIES:

On July 15, 2020, Murrey's Disposal Company, Inc. (Murrey's Disposal or Company), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a complaint against Waste Management of Washington, Inc. (WMW), Waste Management Disposal Services of Oregon, Inc. (WMDSO), and Daniel Anderson Trucking and Excavation, LLC (DAT) (collectively, Respondents), asking the Commission to order WMW, WMDSO, and DAT to cease and desist from engaging in the collection and transportation of solid waste without a certificate from the Commission under RCW 81.77.040 and to find that certain intermodal motor carrier transportation services offered by WMW or WMDSO are not preempted by 49 C.F.R. § 1090.2.

On August 4, 2020, Respondents filed with the Commission Answers to the Complaint and a Motion to Dismiss pursuant to WAC 480-07-380(1).

The Commission may set a deadline for any responses to a motion to dismiss pursuant to WAC 480-07-380. Accordingly, the Commission requires the filing of any responses to Respondents' Motion to Dismiss by 5 p.m. on Thursday, August 20, 2020.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That any party intending to file a response to Respondents' Motion to Dismiss must file a written response by August 20, 2020.
