Enclosed are proposed revisions to Tariff No. 4 of Torre Refuse & Recycling d/b/a Sunshine Disposal & Recycling (G-260) in Spokane County. The purpose of this filing is to increase refuse rates due to increased operating costs.

If approved, these proposed rates will generate approximately \$443,000 annually or about 7.8% on tariff revenue.

Supporting workpapers as required by WAC 480-07-520 are enclosed, along with the proposed notice to customers that will sent on or about March 29, 2022

A copy of this notice has been provided to the chair of the county commission of Spokane County.
