RE: In the Matter of Amending, Adopting, and Repealing WAC 480-100-238, Relating to Integrated Resource Planning. Docket UE-190698

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) is currently in the process of gathering information related to its integrated resource plan (IRP) rules in WAC 480-100-238. The Commission is considering what additional rules are necessary to clarify the methods for incorporating greenhouse gas pollution costs in resource planning, evaluation, and selection (RCW 19.280.030).

On January 16, 2020, the Commission and the Washington Department of Commerce (Commerce) will hold a joint workshop with a focus on approaches to modeling the social cost of greenhouse gases for integrated resource planning. The agenda will include presentations from experts on modeling approaches and will include time for workshop participants to ask questions. A full workshop agenda will be issued in this docket prior to the date of the workshop.
