Air Liquide America Corporation ("Air Liquide"), Air Products and Chemicals, Inc. ("Air Products"), The Boeing Company ("Boeing"), CNC Containers ("CNC"), Equilon Enterprises, LLC ("Equilon"), Georgia-Pacific West, Inc. ("G-P"), and Tesoro Northwest company ("Tesoro") (collectively "Complainants"), have filed before the Commission today a Formal Complaint Requesting an Emergency Adjudicative Proceeding. The complainant alleges, among other things that Puget Sound Energy ("Respondent" or "PSE"), has charged, and is charging, rates under Rate Schedule 48 and various special contracts that are not just, fair, and reasonable, in violation RCW 80.28.010.

The prehearing conference set by this notice is being held pursuant to Part IV of chapter 34.05 RCW pertaining to adjudicative proceedings, including but not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Title 80 RCW, having legal authority to regulate the rates, services, and practices of electric utilities. Statues involved, in addition to those previously cited, include those within chapters 80.04 and 80.28 RCW relating to rates, including but not limited to RCW 80.01.040, RCW 80.04.250, RCW 80.28.010, RCW 80.28.020, RCW 80.28.090, and RCW 80.28.100. Rules involved include those within chapters 480-09 and 480-100 WAC.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That, in accordance with WAC 480-09-700(1)(a), the Commission has determined that good cause exists for this matter to be heard on shortened notice.
