the Commission's intent in regard to matters of interest to them. While PacifiCorp does not agree
with some of the specific assertions made in the petitions of Staff and Public Counsel, it concurs
with all of the petitions to the extent they seek greater clarity with respect to the Order.

PacifiCorp's specific responses to some of the Staff and Public Counsel comments are as follows:

- 1. Staff's suggestion that each of the Applicants be required to "match each element of its estimated sales proceeds to the corresponding cost that the proceeds were designed to recover" is unworkable because the sale of the Plant and Mine were not structured in that fashion. With the exception of the understanding that PacifiCorp would receive a share of the proceeds from the sale sufficient to cover its book breakeven investment in the Mine, none of the sale proceeds were otherwise allocated to costs associated with the Plant.
- 2. The Staff asserts that on Table 5 (page 31 of the Order) the "ratepayer total" amount 14 for PacifiCorp is shown incorrectly as "13.29," whereas the correct value is "13.89" (12.88 plus 15 1.01). While at first blush this would appear to be the case, on closer review of the earlier tables, 16 it appears that it is the "12.88" value that was incorrectly calculated. In Table 4, the 17 Accumulated Depreciation (pre-tax) value is "18.88". Although Table 5 purports to apply a 35% 18 19 tax rate, there is an apparent error between Tables 4 and 5 to the extent that a 32% tax rate was 20 apparently applied to the "18.88" value. If the 35% tax rate is used, the Accumulated 21 Depreciation value in Table 5 would be "12.27". Adding 12.27 to 1.01 produces the 13.28 22 Ratepayer Total in Table 5. (The difference between 13.28 and 13.29 is likely due to rounding). 23 The modification to Table 5 should therefore be a change to the "Accumulated Depreciation" 24 value rather than the "Ratepayer Total" value, to be consistent with the apparent logic of the 25 Order. As discussed below, the appropriate tax rate should be 37.95% to reflect state taxes. 26 2 - PACIFICORP'S ANSWER TO PETITIONS FOR RECONSIDERATION Page

1	3. Public Counsel's suggestion that Washington customers should not be responsible for			
2	taxes imposed by other states is misplaced. PacifiCorp's use of a 37.95% tax rate was part of its			
3	original filing and has not been contested by any party. The use of this effective tax rate is			
4	consistent with the manner in which PacifiCorp reports its results of operations in Washington			
5	and is recognized by the Company's Interjurisdictional Taskforce on Allocations as appropriate.			
6	Staff apparently agrees that this is the correct value. In any event, it is inappropriate for Public			
7	Counsel to raise the issue for the first time in the context of a motion for reconsideration.			
8	4. Public Counsel also seeks to raise a new issue in respect to the need for			
10	sanctions/incentives to cause the Applicants to show proper enthusiasm in seeking the revenue			
11	ruling from the Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") that the Order requires them to obtain.			
12	PacifiCorp has every intention of seeking the revenue ruling in good faith. However, it is bound			
13	to accurately state the facts underlying its request and to bring relevant case authority to the			
14				
15	likely itself have to be disclosed to the IRS and a sanction might be deemed to represent an			
16 17	improper means of accomplishing indirectly a "flow through" of benefits that is improper if done			
1 7	directly.
