TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 21, 2022, Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities (Avista or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions in Docket UE-220053 to its currently effective electric service tariff, Tariff WN U-28, and in Docket UG-220054 to its natural gas service tariff, Tariff WN U-29.

On January 27, 2022, the Commission issued Order 01, which consolidated the dockets and suspended the tariff revisions.

On February 3, 2022, the Commission issued a Notice of Virtual Prehearing Conference and Notice of Second Virtual Prehearing Conference (Notice). The Notice indicated that the Commission would hold the initial prehearing conference in these consolidated matters on shortened notice on February 14, 2022, and that any party seeking intervention should file its petition by February 8, 2022.

On February 14, 2022, the Commission held a virtual prehearing conference before Administrative Law Judge Andrew O'Connell.

On February 16, 2022, Walmart Inc. (Walmart) filed both a Petition to Intervene and a Late Filed Petition for Leave to Intervene (Petitions).

Consistent with WAC 480-07-355, parties may file a written response to the Petitions. The Commission establishes by this Notice that parties must file any response by February 22, 2022.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That any party intending to respond to Walmart's Petitions must file a written response by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, February 22, 2022.
