TO THE PARTIES:

On September 21, 2007, the Commission suspended the procedural schedule in this docket to allow time for the parties to file motions, responses and replies concerning various interlocutory matters concerning the scope of this proceeding. The Commission subsequently established a schedule for the parties to file their motions, responses and replies. Most recently, on November 2, 2007, the Commission revised the previously established schedule, setting new dates for replies to be filed in late November and early December.

On November 16, 2007, AT&T filed a letter requesting suspension of all procedural dates. AT&T states that the parties have been engaged in settlement discussions and believe they are close enough to reaching an agreement that the best use of their resources would be to focus on those discussions. AT&T states it is authorized to represent that Qwest concurs in the request for suspension of all procedural dates.

The parties have established good cause to suspend the calendar in this proceeding. The Commission accordingly will suspend the pending procedural dates. The parties should keep the presiding officer apprised of developments in their ongoing efforts to settle their dispute.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that all procedural dates previously established in this proceeding are suspended until further notice or order setting a new procedural schedule.
