4 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

8 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) as Manager, Regulatory  
9 Initiatives & Tariffs.

10 **Q. What are your duties as Manager, Regulatory Initiatives & Tariffs?**

11 A. I am responsible for: the management and direction of the preparation of tariff  
12 and other regulatory filings; the research and development of regulatory policy  
13 and strategy on tariff and other regulatory initiatives; and the interpretation of  
14 tariffs and rate schedules. I have been employed by PSE since 1997, working in  
15 the area of Rates and Regulatory Affairs. I have been involved with several  
16 optional tariff schedule services over the past several years, such as the updated  
17 electric Schedule 62 – Substation and Related Equipment Capacity and the natural  
18 gas Schedule 54 – Optional Gas Compression Service.

19 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

20 A I hold a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics from the University of  
21 Washington. I have over twenty-five years of utility experience, primarily
