

1 **PREHEARING CONFERENCE:** The Commission convened a second prehearing conference in Docket No. UE-001952 in Olympia, Washington, on December 22, 2000, before Administrative Law Judge Dennis J. Moss. The Complaint in Docket No. UE-001952 asks the Commission to proceed under its authority to conduct emergency adjudicative proceedings. RCW 34.05.479; WAC 480-09-510. Accordingly, the matter was convened on shortened notice.


Additional process and procedural dates may be established by subsequent notice or order.

6 **DISCOVERY DISPUTES:** The presiding Administrative Law Judge will be available during the time scheduled for depositions to rule immediately in the event that a dispute arises during the course of a deposition. Other discovery disputes that the Parties are unable to resolve quickly should be brought to the attention of the presiding Administrative Law Judge via written motion setting forth the particulars of the dispute. A motions conference then will be set on shortened notice, typically on the same day the motion is filed. Participation via telephone conference will be permitted; the official record of motions conferences will be made on audio tape.

7 **NOTICE TO PARTIES:** Any objection to the provisions of this Order must be filed within ten (10) days after the date of mailing of this statement, pursuant to WAC 480-09-460(2). Absent such objections, this prehearing conference order will control further proceedings in this matter, subject to Commission review.
