6	3.	Any protest of a temporary certificate is unnecessary and inappropriate when the
7		holder of the temporary certificate submits application for a permanent certificate
8		within thirty days of issuance of the temporary certificate, as has occurred with respect
9		to Kitsap Ferry Company, LLC. A protest, if any is allowed, should be submitted in
10		response to the application for permanent authority. WAC 480-51-060(8).
