Dear Ms. Washburn:

Please find enclosed a proposed stipulated order reinstating Inmate Communications Corporation as a telecommunications company and imposing a \$2,000 penalty for failing to file its 2003 and 2004 annual reports on time. The proposed order is the result of discussions between Commission staff and Inmate Communications and is endorsed by both parties.

Inmate Communications says it was unaware of the Commission's initial order revoking its status as a telecommunications company. Thus, it continued to operate in Washington despite the Commission's order. After Inmate learned that its status was revoked it came into compliance with its annual reporting obligations. It also promised better compliance in the future. Commission Staff sought and the Company agreed to a \$2,000 penalty for failing to file timely annual reports in 2003 and 2004.
