**Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules:** Substitute Senate Bill 6473 (SSB 6473), Chapter 347, Laws of 2006, eliminates price list requirements for telecommunications services effective June 8, 2006.

The statutory change allows the Commission to amend and adopt rules that will require companies to communicate with customers directly using a written contract or customer service agreement instead of using price lists.

The Commission received four written stakeholder comments in support of repealing rules concerning price lists and filing of price lists.

The Commission proposes changes deleting references to price lists and filing requirements to reflect the review of existing rules and in response to comments received.
