McChord believes that the intent is to have the operators continue to complete a standardized form (presently Form 024-025) that is provided by the commission yearly which requires all the information listed in the WAC section as revised. McChord asserts that, as worded, this section leaves open to interpretation the definition of a "report" and the amount of detail required. McChord recommends the following language in WAC 480-75-650 (2) "A report form titled, "Hazardous Liquid Annual Report Form" which can be obtained from the Pipeline Safety Section of the commission.
