Enclosed herewith are proposed tariff 13, pages 1, 15, 20-21, 25 and 27-9 for Basin Disposal of WA, LLC dba Basin Disposal of Walla Walla, issued November 10, 2009 to become effective January 1, 2010. The revisions are due to an increase in the Council of City of Walla Walla disposal fees from \$51.45 to \$59.17 per ton, a 15% increase as of January 1, 2010. The revenue increase will be \$15,116 for drop box customers, \$58,567 (7.55%) for residential customers, \$25,346 (7.55%) for commercial packer customers, overall, (3.6% of total revenue) and 73 cents per month (1 can weekly service). Customers received notices of the changes with the first billing reflecting the increases.
