The 2011 Legislature amended the underground utilities law, Chapter 19.122 RCW. These changes take effect on January 1, 2013. This new law, assigned to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), affects the Commission's authority to enforce the underground utilities law as it relates to pipelines. The Commission initiated this rulemaking to require gas pipeline companies to report additional information about damage to their facilities caused by excavators that have violated the underground utilities law, and to provide to violators information about their rights under the revised law. Reasons supporting proposal: Proposed revisions will provide sufficient supplemental reporting and evidentiary records and documentation needed by the Commission to sustain an action to enforce violations of Chapter 19.122 RCW.
