RE: In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties Against Daniel Stein, d/b/a Seabeck Waste & Recycle, Docket TG-180181

TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 10, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02, Initial Order Classifying Respondent as a Solid Waste Collection Carrier; Ordering Respondent to Cease and Desist; Imposing and Suspending Penalties on Condition of Future Compliance (Order 02) against Daniel Stein, d/b/a Seabeck Waste & Recycle, (Seabeck Waste or Company). Order 02 imposed a penalty of \$2,000 against Seabeck Waste, \$1,000 of which was suspended for two years, to be waived thereafter, subject to the conditions that: a) Seabeck Waste refrain from operating as a solid waste collection carrier in Washington without first obtaining the required certificate, and b) Seabeck pay the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On July 30, 2020, Staff filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had timely paid the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and that Staff believes the Company has refrained from operating as a solid waste collection carrier without a certificate. Staff recommends the suspended penalty be waived.

The Commission finds that Seabeck Waste has complied with the conditions of Order 02. The \$1,000 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and this docket is closed.
