ERRATA TO ORDER 01

RE: *In the Matter of Pacific Power & Light Company 2020-2029 Ten-Year Achievable Electric Conservation Potential and 2020-2021 Biennial Conservation Target Under RCW 19.285.040 and WAC 480-109-010*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 1, 2019, Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power or the Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) its 2020-2021 Biennial Conservation Plan (Plan) to comply with Washington Administrative Code 480-109-010.

On December 17, 2019, the Commission issued Order 01, Accepting 2020-2029 Ten-Year Achievable Conservation Potential and 2020-2021 Biennial Conservation Target, Subject to Conditions (Order 01). It has come to the Commission's attention that paragraph 2 and Table 2 contain errors. The Commission hereby corrects those errors below.

Corrected paragraph 2:

- 2 On November 1, 2019, Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power or Company) filed its 2020-2021 Biennial Conservation Plan (BCP or Plan) identifying a 2020-2029 ten-year achievable conservation potential of 509,495 megawatt-hours (MWh) and a 2020-2021 biennial conservation target/EIA Target of 93,189 MWh.
