NOTICE SUSPENDING PAYMENT PLAN
(Next Installment Payment due by 5 p.m. on November 23, 2020)

RE: *In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment against Vicky Sandhu, d/b/a Seattle Top Class Limo, in the amount of \$3,800,*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 20, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment (Penalty Assessment) against Vicky Sandhu, d/b/a Seattle Top Class Limo, (Seattle Top Class Limo or Company) in the amount of \$3,800 for violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-30. On March 16, 2020, the Commission entered Order 01, Granting Mitigation, in Part, Imposing and Suspending Penalty, which imposed a reduced penalty of \$3,040, a \$2,500 portion of which was suspended subject to conditions. On March 24 2020, the Commission entered Order 02, Granting Payment Arrangement (Order 02). Among other provisions, Order 02 approved a payment plan that permitted Seattle Top Class Limo to pay the \$550 portion of the penalty that was not suspended in five monthly installments, the first of which will be due on June 22, 2020.

On June 8, 2020, the Company filed with the Commission a request for extension of its payment arrangement. In its request, the Company explains that it is currently not operating due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and that it will not be permitted to resume operations until the state of Washington enters Phase 3 of its gradual reopening. On June 10, 2020, Commission staff filed a response recommending the Commission grant the Company's request and postpone the payment arrangement for five months.

Due to the economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Commission exercises its discretion to grant the Company's request and suspend the payment plan for a period of five months. Accordingly, the installments are now due as follows:

All other terms and conditions of Order 02 remain in full force and effect.
