In December 2022, the Company received \$236,864 from the universal communications services program for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.

High speed data (SHSD) DSL, 100G OSP, capacity and bonding all bring faster broadband to more locations. Projects also include routine capex projects including drops, cards, line extensions and mandatory facility moves. The funds received from the universal communications services program can be viewed as contributing to the Company's ability to perform these projects and helping to recover normal operating expenses. The Company opens all major projects that are budgeted early in the year thus those described above will continue throughout 2023 in addition to routine maintenance, cable additions and other projects as needed. Details for 2022 expenditures are included in Report 1 of the annual ETC filing submitted on or around July 1.
