Enclosed are proposed revisions to Tariff No. 10.1 of Ada-Lin Waste Systems, Inc. (G-104) in Lincoln and Adams Counties. The purpose of this filing is to increase refuse rates due to increased operating costs.

If approved, these proposed rates will generate approximately \$184,800 annually or about 17.9% on tariff revenue.

Supporting workpapers as required by WAC 480-07-520 are enclosed, along with the proposed notice to customer that will be sent on or about May 30, 2023

A copy of this notice has been provided to the chair of the county commissions of Lincoln and Adams Counties.
