NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Clutter, Inc., Docket TV-200432

TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 25, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; Notice of Prehearing Conference (Complaint) against Clutter, Inc. (Clutter or Company), which alleged that Clutter violated Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15 a total of 390 times. The Complaint scheduled a prehearing conference on Tuesday, May 4, 2021.

On May 5, 2021, the Commission entered Order 02, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (Order 02) in this docket, which established a procedural schedule including an evidentiary hearing set for July 26, 2021.

On June 11, 2021, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket to inform the Commission that Staff and the Company (collectively, the Parties) have reached a full settlement in principle and request that the Commission cancel the current procedural schedule.

The Commission finds good cause to suspend the procedural schedule, and thus grants the Parties' request. The Parties must submit to the Commission a proposal for a revised procedural schedule that allows for consideration of the settlement by 5 p.m. on Friday, July 2, 2021.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the Commission hereby suspends the procedural schedule in Docket TV-200432.
