RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against, Simba Movers LLC, Docket TV-210157

## TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 17, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a $\$ 3,500$ penalty against Simba Movers LLC (Simba Movers or Company) in Docket TV-210157 (Penalty Assessment).

On October 11, 2021, the Commission entered Order 01, Denying Mitigation (Order 01), which denied mitigation of the penalty, but approved a monthly payment schedule to conclude in April 2023.

On January 11, 2023, the Commission canceled the Company's household goods permit in Docket TV-230021 for failure to file acceptable proof of insurance. On March 3, 2023, Simba Movers was administratively dissolved by the Washington Secretary of State for failure to file its 2022 annual report.

On June 1, 2023, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that, to date, Simba Movers has paid only $\$ 2,350$ of the penalty. Staff recommends that the Commission should cancel the payment arrangement. Staff further recommends that the remaining $\$ 1,150$ penalty balance should become due and payable upon the Company either: (1) applying for reinstatement of its household goods permit; or (2) being found to be operating as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington without the required permit.

Due to the Company's failure to comply with the terms of Order 01, the payment schedule is canceled, and the $\$ 1,150$ remaining portion of the penalty will become due and payable according to Staff's recommendation.
