As Manager of Total Energy System Planning, Ms. Koch was responsible for oversight of gas and electric infrastructure planning including projects such as the Ardmere Substation, and she was engaged in the initial planning development of the Ardmere Substation and participated in several meetings as noted in PSE's Response to ICNU Data Request No. 040; Doc 1_ Nov 2005 Planning Summary and PCR 1 Ardmere. Ms. Koch is currently the Director of Planning for PSE. In this position she is responsible for the planning, analysis and budgeting of gas and electric infrastructure needs. Ms. Koch prepared her rebuttal testimony relative to the Ardmere Substation, in part, from the facts included in the over 529 documents provided in PSE's Response to ICNU Data Request No. 040.
