In consultation with Commission Staff the Company is re-submitting Attachment 3, electric decoupling baseline revenue per customer, to correct an inadvertent formula error that impacted the monthly decoupled revenue per customer for residential customers on page 3. The annual revenue per customer remains unchanged but the monthly weather normalized volumes and monthly decoupled revenue per customer amounts for March, April, May, and July were corrected. There are no other number changes or tariff changes associated with the revised attachment.

In addition, the Company is re-submitting tariff Schedule 46. It was discovered that rate code 635 included an incorrect value (\$14.49 instead of \$11.49). The Company has corrected this inadvertent error on the tariff sheet detailed below.
