PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp or Company) submits the enclosed net power cost (NPC) update consistent with paragraphs 20 and 21 of the stipulation filed on July 20, 2020. This update considers a deviation of approximately \$19.8 million in the positive direction from the NPC baseline that was estimated in the settlement. This estimate is larger than what PacifiCorp, Staff, Public Counsel, PCA, TEP, and Walmart (collectively, the Parties) anticipated during settlement. PacifiCorp is working with Parties to maintain the benefits of the stipulation and minimize rate impacts to customers.

Confidential information in support of the filing is being provided subject to the terms and conditions of Order 02 in Docket UE-191024 and Order 02 in Docket UE-180778. The designated information is proprietary and commercially sensitive as it directly relates to PacifiCorp's fuel, dispatch, and other costs.
