TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 27, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Final Order 08/05, Rejecting Tariff Sheets; Granting Petition; Approving and Adopting Partial Multiparty Settlement Stipulation; Resolving Contested Issues; Authorizing and Requiring Compliance Filing (Final Order) in the above-referenced consolidated dockets. The Final Order, among other things, required Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities (Avista or Company) to file quarterly expenditure reports regarding its Wildfire Resiliency Plan (Wildfire) and Energy Imbalance Markets (EIM) investments.

On January 14, 2022, Avista filed its Wildfire and EIM capital expenditure report for the period ending December 31, 2021 (Report).

On January 26, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket stating that it has reviewed the Report and believes that it complies with the Wildfire and EIM capital expenditure reporting requirements in the Final Order.

The Commission has reviewed the Report and finds that it complies with the Final Order.
