Please identify the counterparties for energy transactions included in PSE's California Receivables claim and provide the specific portion of PSE's claim that relates to failure by SCE and PG&E to make timely or complete payments to the ISO and PX for power received.

**Response:**

Please see Puget Sound Energy, Inc.'s ("PSE") Response to Public Counsel Data Request No. 10 for information regarding the California Receivables claim. As indicated in Attachment A to PSE's Response to Public Counsel Data Request No. 10, PSE's transaction counterparty for all of the California Receivable was the California Independent System Operator ("Cal ISO"), due to the requirements on the market created by California law. The Cal ISO purchased power on behalf of the California utilities (including Pacific Gas & Electric and Southern California Edison) that were required to participate in, and obtain power exclusively through, the Cal ISO and Power Exchange markets.
