Dear Ms. Washburn:

Pursuant to the above-referenced order, Puget Sound Energy (PSE) submitted to the Commission on October 30, 2001, a report evaluating the PEM Program from its conception through September 30, 2001, with Appendices. PSE is now submitting a revised evaluation report and Appendix I (both of which are confidential and are proprietary in nature and are in a sealed envelope marked CONFIDENTIAL) to replace the report and Appendix I originally submitted to the Commission on October 30, 2001. Accordingly, with regard to these items, the Company claims confidentiality and protection from inspection or copying under WAC 480-09-015. As required by WAC 480-09-015(4), the Company identifies itself, its shareholders and its customers as the parties which might be directly affected by disclosure of the confidential information.

This revised report corrects a computational error found in the analysis of the energy conservation impacts of the TOD pricing program. The analysis of load shifting from peak to off-peak periods was not affected by this error. While this revision changes some of the nominal load reduction results, it does not change the overall conclusion that the TOD Pilot saved energy, nor the magnitude of the savings.

The conservation impact results table and discussion highlighted on pages 4 and 5 of this revised report reflect the corrected results from the Brattle Group. A revised report and technical appendices from the Brattle Group is attached as Appendix I.
