**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND TO
PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

TO PARTIES OF RECORD:

On April 15, 2002, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed a Petition for Reconsideration of the Commission's 30th Supplemental Order Addressing Qwest's Performance Assurance Plan (QPAP). Any party wishing to respond to Qwest's petition for reconsideration must do so by the close of business, **Wednesday, May 1, 2002**. The Commission will enter an order resolving the petition for reconsideration and responses by **Friday, May 17, 2002**.

On April 16, 2002, Qwest filed a request with the Commission to postpone the date upon which Qwest must make a compliance filing concerning the Commission's final order on the QPAP. Qwest requests that any compliance filing be postponed until after a Commission order on reconsideration of the issues Qwest raises in its petition for reconsideration. Qwest's request was granted during the April 18, 2002 prehearing conference in this proceeding. On the understanding that the Commission will enter an order on reconsideration on May 17, 2002, Qwest must make a compliance filing with the Commission on **Friday, May 24, 2002**.
