**NOTICE OF FURTHER SUSPENSION
OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE
(until Thursday, April 29, 2004)**

RE: In re Application No. GA-079178 of Blaine-Bay Refuse, Inc. For Extension of Authority Under Certificate No. G-145, for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate Motor Vehicles in Furnishing Solid Waste Collection Service, Docket No. TG-030831.

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 14, 2003, the Commission suspended the procedural schedule in this proceeding to January 8, 2004. The Commission determined that Blaine-Bay's Motion to Amend Order M.V.G. No. 656, docketed as TG -031817, which seeks relief in a prior docket that is related to this proceeding should be resolved prior to the issues in this proceeding. The Commission set a prehearing conference in Docket No. TG -031817 for January 8, 2004, as well.

During the January 8, 2004, prehearing conference, the parties requested that the suspension of Docket No. TG -030831 be continued until the resolution of the Motion to Amend. The parties acknowledged that a decision in the Motion to Amend proceeding could eliminate the need to go forward with the application for extension in this proceeding.

The Commission observes that resolution of the issues in the Motion to Amend may impact the course of the proceedings in this docket. Accordingly, the Commission extends the suspension of the procedural schedule in this proceeding to **April 29, 2004**. The parties are directed to file a status letter with the Commission by **April 29, 2004**.
