
Description of amendment:

Change rates for embedded base DSO UNE-P lines.

The amendment amends the interconnection agreement first accepted by the Commission on 12/31/03 (date) in WUTC Docket No. UT-033062 (current docket number). That agreement was originally approved by the Commission on 8/25/97 (date) in WUTC Docket No. UT-960307 (original docket number) between Company A and Company C, AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest, Inc. (name of company C).

Company A represents that the amendment does not discriminate against non-party carriers, that it is consistent with state and federal law, and that it is in the public interest. By virtue of Company B's signature on the amendment, Company A believes that Company B agrees with these representations.
