## NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED STATUS CONFERENCE (Set for Tuesday, June 21, 2011, at 10:30 a.m.)

RE: WUTC v. Trashbusters of Washington State, LLC, Docket TG-101639

## TO ALL PARTIES:

On February 2, 2011, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) convened a hearing on the merits of the complaint in this docket. At that hearing, Staff and Trashbusters of Washington State, LLC (Trashbusters) agreed that Trashbusters' certificate of public convenience and necessity should not be canceled if the company timely performed certain actions during February and March 2011. Further, Commission Staff expressed willingness to dismiss the complaint if Trashbusters resolved all compliance issues.

Initially, the Commission scheduled a status conference for Thursday, April 14, 2011, at 1:30 p.m., to ensure that all terms of the compliance agreement had been accomplished or, in the alternative, allow inquiry into any unforeseen circumstances that may have prevented Trashbusters from satisfying its obligations. Later, the Commission granted Commission Staff's request for a continuance and reset the status conference for May 19, 2011.

On May 18, 2011, Commission Staff again requested that the Commission postpone the status conference. As with its previous request, Staff cites to a continuing need for additional time to review Trashbusters' filings associated with its 2009 and 2010 regulatory fees. Trashbusters does not object to this delay and confirmed its availability for rescheduling during the week of June 20-24, 2011, as proposed by Commission Staff.

Commission Staff's request to postpone the status conference is granted. The request complies with the requirements in WAC 480-07-385 for such requests, and will not prejudice

the parties or the Commission. However, Commission Staff should ensure that all required analysis of Trashbusters' filings related to regulatory fees is completed as soon as possible, eliminating the need for further postponements in this docket.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE THAT the status conference set for Thursday, May 19, 2011, at 1:30 p.m. is postponed until Tuesday, June 21, 2011, at 10:30 a.m. The status conference will be conducted in Olympia in Room 108 of the Commission's headquarters, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S.
