RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Four Seasons Moving & Storage LLC*
Commission Staff Compliance Update for Order 01 and Recommendation
Docket TV-220338

Dear Mr. Killip:

On July 5, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission entered Order 01 (Order) in Docket TV-220338. Including other actions, Order 01 assessed a \$1,000 penalty against Four Seasons Moving & Storage LLC, (Four Seasons or Company) and suspended a \$500 portion of the penalty for two years, and then waived, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Four Seasons must maintain a conditional safety rating;
- (2) Commission staff (Staff) conduct a follow-up investigation at least six months from the effective date of the Order;
- (3) Four Seasons must not incur any repeat acute or critical violations of WAC 480-15 upon reinspection;
and
- (4) The Company pay the \$500 portion of the penalty that is not suspended.

On July 15, 2022, Four Seasons paid the \$500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended in full.

On May 3, 2023, Staff completed the required follow-up investigation, which resulted in a satisfactory safety rating. The Company did not receive any repeat acute or critical violations.

Staff finds that Four Seasons satisfied the conditions of Order 01 and recommends that the \$500 suspended penalty be waived.
