 Final Order Dismissing  
 Monetary Penalty Assessment

On January 6, 1993, the Commission levied an administrative monetary penalty assessment in the amount of \$10,000 against San Juan Airlines, Inc., d/b/a Shuttle Express, C-1918. Said penalty assessment was levied against the company for twenty violations of state statute and Commission regulations.

Following petition filed by San Juan Airlines, the Commission reconsidered its decision. On March 23, 1993, the Commission rendered a decision reaffirming the penalty but suspending it on condition that the respondent seek amendment of its permit and that the company remain free of similar violations for a period of two years.

It now appearing that San Juan Airlines has met all conditions contained in the order of March 23, 1993, the Commission is of the opinion that the entire amount of the penalty should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED That whereas the conditions previously set by the Commission have been met, monetary penalty assessment TC-910789 in the amount of \$10,000 is hereby dismissed.
