WAC 480-120-X30--Company responsibility.

When a customer informs the commission that the customer has identified a problem with service or billing or other matters and the customer has been told by two or more companies that the problem is not that company's responsibility but another company's responsibility, commission staff will inform the companies involved.

Once the commission has contacted the companies involved, the companies must confer with each other within 48 hours and determine which company will take responsibility to resolve the customer's problem. The company accepting responsibility must contact the commission and begin resolution of the problem within 24 hours of the time allotted by this section for a conference between the companies.

Companies must confer, allocate responsibility between the companies, and contact the commission, as required by this section, or the commission may issue penalties to one or more of the involved companies.
