TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD:

PLEASE BE ON NOTICE THAT the Commission will conduct additional hearing proceedings in these dockets in the Commission's Hearing Room (Room 206) at its offices in Olympia, Washington on Monday, January 29, 2001, beginning at 1:30 p.m. The purpose of these proceedings is to determine the details of the temporary relief that is to be afforded in accordance with the Commission's Order, entered today, resolving Phase One. This hearing session will be conducted in the fashion of a technical conference to determine what specific tariff language is necessary to implement a soft cap as an alternative under the Optional Price Stability provisions of Schedule 48 and the PSE/Georgia Pacific Special Contract, as discussed in the Commission Order. Each party must bring to this hearing session all representatives, including staff members and consultants, who have the necessary experience and authority to state the party's views on resolving all matters necessary to effect the soft-cap remedy that the Commission adopted. In addition, other matters may be discussed as necessary to implement the Commission order.
