The following bench request regards appendices to the parties' settlement stipulation, and directs PacifiCorp to file a response. If there is any party not in agreement with the response, that party should file a separate response.

TO PACIFICORP:

BENCH REQUEST NO. 9:

In order to understand the impact of the parties' joint proposal to modify the Settlement Stipulation, the Commission wants information showing the impact the October Net Power Cost Update would have on the revenue requirement in the parties' original Settlement Stipulation.

To allow for this consideration, please provide new versions of Appendix A and Appendix B to the parties' Settlement Stipulation (to be marked and identified as Appendix A – BR9 and Appendix B – BR9, respectively), as requested below. Please provide both the PDF version and native format as required per WAC 480-07-140(6).

- a) In Appendix A – BR9, please update the Settlement Adjustment line "October Net Power Cost Update – Estimate ... (10.50)" with the substitution of the actual October Net Power Cost Update. Please make no other modification that may have been included as a result of the parties' agreed October 28, 2020, modification.
- b) In Appendix B – BR9, please flow-through the impact of the change to Appendix A – BR9 without including any other modification that may have been

included as a result of the parties' agreed October 28, 2020, modification.
