In The Matter Of Fees To Be Paid To The Washington Utilities And Transportation Commission By Transporters Of Household Goods For 2002 Tariff Maintenance Service

ORDER ESTABLISHING TARIFF MAINTENANCE FEES FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2002

BACKGROUND

- RCW 81.80.150 requires the Commission to compile, promulgate, publish, and distribute tariffs setting rates for the transportation of household goods in the state of Washington and to set fees to cover the costs of performing those duties. The Commission publishes and distributes to common carriers Tariff No. 15-A containing rates applying to the transportation of household goods in Washington intrastate commerce. In addition, the Commission periodically amends Tariff No. 15-A, following notice and hearing, by publishing and distributing revised tariff pages to those carriers.
- 2 RCW 81.80.150 also requires that common carriers purchase tariffs from the Commission and to pay fees to the Commission for the service the Commission provides in amending tariffs.
- The 2002 tariff maintenance service fee is now before the Commission for consideration and the Commission, being fully advised, has considered all monies on hand, the number of tariffs anticipated to be produced in 2002, and the anticipated costs of producing and distributing such tariffs and directs the Secretary to enter the following order.

4 IT IS ORDERED That the fee to be paid to the Commission under the provisions of RCW 81.80.150 for tariff maintenance service for Tariff No.15-A is fixed at \$25.00 per tariff maintenance subscription.
