BACKGROUND

- On November 28, 2001, Harold LeMay Enterprises d/b/a Harbor Disposal., (Harbor) filed with the Commission revisions to its currently effective Tariff Number 11, designated as tenth revision page 1, fifth revision page 12, fifth revision page 14, third revision page 15, fifth revision page 19, and fifth revision page 20. The stated effective date is January 5, 2002. The filing is to recover a disposal fee increase mandated by Grays Harbor County.
- WAC 480-70-266 requires forty days' notice prior to the effective date of the tariff. The tariff sheet bears an inserted effective date of January 5, 2002. This date recognizes statutory notice as required. Harbor requests, however, that statutory notice be waived as authorized in WAC 480-70-276, and that the revisions become effective January 1, 2002.
- This matter was brought before the Commission at its regularly scheduled open meeting on December 28, 2001. The Commissioners having determined the following order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter the following order and related provisions.

FINDINGS

After careful examination of the proposed tariff revisions filed by Harbor on November 21, 2001, and giving consideration to all relevant matters and for good cause shown, the Commission finds that the proposed tariff revisions should become effective January 1, 2002.

ORDER

- 5 IT IS ORDERED that the Carrier is authorized to implement and collect, the rates contained in Docket TG-011560.
- THE COMMISSION GRANTS the requested waiver of statutory notice in connection with the tariff revisions filed by Harbor on November 21, 2001, and the tariff revisions shall become effective on January 1, 2002.
