ORDER GRANTING A LIMITED
WAIVER TO RULE AND GRANTING
COMPANY ADDITIONAL TIME TO
FILE ANNUAL REPORT FORM
(FERC FORM NO. 1)

BACKGROUND

- 1 On March 22, 2002, the Commission received a petition from PacifiCorp ("the Company") requesting that the Commission grant a limited waiver, or an exemption, to the provisions of WAC 480-100-208 that require companies to file an annual report form (FERC Form No. 1) and the state supplement by May 1. The petition requests that PacifiCorp be granted an extension until June 30, 2002, to file the Company's 2001 FERC Form No. 1 and accompanying documents. The petition further requests continuing waivers for future years and permission to file the Annual Report on a fiscal year basis.
- 2 WAC 480-100-003 allows electric companies to deviate from the adopted rules with the written permission of the Commission.

ORDER

- 3 PacifiCorp is granted a limited waiver to the provisions of WAC 480-100-208 which require an annual report form (FERC Form No. 1) and state supplement to be received by May 1 of each year. PacifiCorp is granted an extension until June 30, 2002, to file the Company's 2001 FERC Form No. 1 and accompanying documents.
- 4 PacifiCorp is denied its request for continuing waivers of WAC 480-100-208 and must file any requests for extensions of filing dates in a timely manner when necessary. The request to file data on a fiscal year basis is also denied. The Annual Reports will be filed with calendar year data.
