ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

**BACKGROUND**

1 On April 18, 2002, Puget Sound Energy (PSE or the Company) filed with the  
Commission a petition for an extension to file the Commission Basis Reports for both  
electric and gas to November 15, 2002. According to PSE, compliance with both  
WAC 480-100-208 (2) and WAC 480-90-208 (2) would be an administrative burden  
at this time. PSE notes that it has submitted detailed financial information related to  
its recent general rate case filing, based upon the twelve months ended June 30, 2001.

**FINDINGS**

- 2 (1) PSE is engaged in the business of electric and gas service within the state of  
Washington as a public service company, and is subject to the jurisdiction of  
the Commission.
- 3 (2) The extension, as described above, does not appear to be unreasonable and  
contrary to the public interest, and the Commission should approve PSE's  
request.

**ORDER**

4 THE COMMISSION GRANTS The petition of PSE for an extension to file the above  
reports.
