Lots 1, 4, 5, 8, 9, 12 and 13, inclusive, in Block 10, TALMADGE ADDITION to the Town of Newport, according to the recorded plat thereof, Pend Oreille County, Washington; EXCEPT that portion of said property conveyed to the State of Washington by Deed recorded in Book 42, page 260, records of Pend Oreille County, Washington.

The unconditioned closure and abandonment of the railroad crossing would restrict, if not eliminate, ingress and egress. It would also eliminate city care and maintenance of the street which services my clients property.
