DESIGNATION OF REVENUES ALLOCABLE TO PUGET POWER CONSERVATION GRANTOR TRUST 1995-1 - This section implements the Washington Conservation Financing Statute, Chapter 268 of Laws of Washington 1994, which provides that the Commission shall approve rates at levels sufficient to recover certain expenditures associated with bondable conservation investment financed by the issuance of trust certificates issued by the Puget Power Conservation Grantor Trust 1995-1. On or after the effective date of this section, the monthly amounts shown following shall be allocated from each Customer's bill to the Puget Power Conservation Grantor Trust 1995-1. As this is an allocation of bills calculated under tariffed rates, Schedule 80, Paragraph 13-c. (Proration of Electric Service Bills) shall not be applied to these allocations.
