

This letter is to request the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to eliminate the following authority from G196:

REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICE consisting of Sludge and/or Dewatered Sludge in the State of Washington under contracts with MUNICIPALITY OF METROPOLITAN SEATTLE, SOLGANIC SERVICES CORPORATION and PIERCE COUNTY UTILITIES DEPARTMENT.

The above authority provides for the transportation of biosolids and recycled liquids that are strictly recycled and covered by our common carrier permit (CC-62030).

Great Western Soil Conditioners, Inc. would like to extend their authority in G-196 to provide grit hauling under contract with King County, formerly Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle, from West Point Treatment Plant and the Renton Treatment Plant to Cedar Hills Landfill or King County Transfer stations.
