**NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE CHANGES FOR ¾" PIPE CUSTOMERS**

Harrison-Ray Water Company, Inc. has asked the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for permission to increase the water rates we charge all our customers. The proposed rates will increase annual revenues to the company by approximately \$65,000 (36%) per year to cover increased expenses due to the new well installed, improvements to the pump house, electricity, insurance, fuel, etc. If approved the new rates will be effective October 1, 2007. The rate increase will be based on water used after October 1, and reflected on your November 2007 billing.

Below is a table showing the current and proposed water rates (cu ft = cubic feet):

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE CHANGES FOR 2" PIPE CUSTOMERS**

Harrison-Ray Water Company, Inc. has asked the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for permission to increase the water rates we charge all our customers. The proposed rates will increase annual revenues to the company by approximately \$65,000 (36%) per year to cover increased expenses due to the new well installed, improvements to the pump house, electricity, insurance, fuel, etc. If approved the new rates will be effective October 1, 2007. The rate increase will be based on water used after October 1, and reflected on your November 2007 billing.
